RULES AND REGULATIONS.

1. The Library shall be open each week day, (except legal holidays,) from 2 o'clock p. m. to 6 o'clock p. m. and from 7 o'clock p. m. to 9 o'clock p. m., and Sundays from 3 o'clock p. m. to 6 o'clock p. m.
2. No books of reference shall be taken from the Library.
3. No person shall be allowed more than one volume and one magazine at the same time.
4. No books taken from the Library shall be retained more than fourteen days, nor be loaned to any one not a member of the same household; provided, always, that any book may be renewed once to the same person.
5. No magazine shall be retained more than seven days, under a penalty of a fine of 2c. per day for all delay.
6. All books shall be returned within fourteen days from the date of delivery, under penalty of 2c. per day for all delay.
7. All injury to books, beyond all reasonable wear, and all losses of books shall be made good to the satisfaction of the librarian.
8. No person shall be allowed to take a book from the Library when they are owing anything by reason of injuries to, or for loss of books, or fine for delay in returning a book. Nor will any book be acknowledged returned unless delivered to the librarian.
9. It shall be the duty of the librarian to collect all fines arising from delay in returning books, or for loss of same.
10. All persons visiting the library shall be required to conduct themselves quietly, and any person abusing the privileges of the Library by loud talking or other offensive conduct, shall be denied admission to the library building.
